The Royalty for the ***“World Championship & Golden Cup”*** is  
€ 50.000,- (fifty thousand/00 Euros).

The Royalty for the ***“Continental Championship”***  
***(European, Asian, Pan-American, African, Australian)***  
is € 30.000,- (thirty thousand/00 Euros).

The Royalty, for the ***“World Olympus Games”***, is  
€ 20.000,- (twenty thousand/00 Euros)

The Royalty, for the ***“World Cup”***, is  
€ 20.000,- (twenty thousand/00 Euros)

The Royalty, for the ***“EuroCup”***, is  
€ 5.000,- (five thousand/00 Euros)

The agreement will be valid when the bank transfer on World Martial Kombat Federation current account in Geneva (Switzerland) is completed.

The bank transfer has to be executed:

- the 20% at the confirmation of the agreement
- the 80% 60 days before the beginning of the Championship

In a particular case, the bank transfer can be executed in different time and way.

The General Secretary will send, promptly, the acquisition document to the organizing entity.
